2. What is your high school GPA? (No minimum requirement. Will be considered and used for statistical tracking.)
3. What is your ACT or SAT score? (No minimum requirement. Will be considered and used for statistical tracking.)

1. Describe your activity in First Tee in the past five years. If there has been a break in that activity, please explain.
2. What have you done to support First Tee Utah? (youth mentor, involve in events, promote to friends)
3. What impact has First Tee had on your life?
4. How has First Tee helped equip you to take on new experiences and challenges?
5. Who has been your First Tee mentor and how have they influenced your personal growth? (coach, staff, fellow participant, etc.)
6. How have you demonstrated a commitment to the game of golf?
7. What do you plan to do as an adult to similarly impact the lives of youth?
8. What do you do to serve others? (volunteer work, community service, work for pay)
9. What are your interests, activities, hobbies other than golf?
10. What has been the hardest obstacle you have had to overcome in your life? How did you handle it? What would you do differently if you had the chance?
11. What would being selected for the First Tee Utah Scholarship mean to you? (financially, personally, in your planning for your future, etc.)
12. Have you been awarded any other scholarships? If so, please list their source and amount.
13. When do you plan to use the scholarship if you receive it? Will you attend school in the next academic year?
